The scheme is linked to the successful 'Bridge Card' programme and provides sportsmen and sportswomen free access to training facilities. Whilst elite athletes are catered for by National Governing Bodies and Sports Council programmes such as Elite Cymru it is our aim to support the development of people with the potential to represent Bridgend on the National and International stage. The scheme focuses on the future plans of athletes rather than past achievement.

Eligibility

Applicants will be residents of Bridgend County Borough

-  The sport will be one that is recognised by Sports Council for Wales with an appropriate National Governing Body
-  Applicants will identify their proposed programme and targeted achievements for the forthcoming year
-  Applicants will generally have achieved National standards in their sport or be involved in a high performance programme recognised by the National Governing Body
-  The application, including targeted achievement, will be endorsed by an appropriate coach and governing body officer
-  We operate an equity policy and applications from females and people with disabilities are encouraged

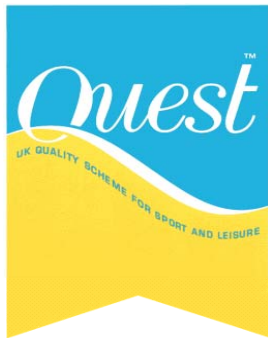
